






Definition of PPE

According to the International Labour Organization (ILO), PPE comprises of "equipment that will protect the user against the risk of accidents or of adverse effects on health"





Safety, Health and Environment National Authority (SHENA) stresses that PPE is the last line of defense when workplace hazards cannot be eliminated or

"The correct use of PPE is applicable to all persons within the relevant workplace and such controls should be adhered to and be suitably managed at all times whilst the hazards exist."

Common PPE in IBTE Workshops



SAFETY HELMETS

Protect your head from falling obiects.



SAFETY SHOES

Protect your feet from sharp materials and slippery surfaces.



GLOVES

Shield your hands from cuts, heat, chemicals and oil.



HEARING PROTECTION EQUIPMENT

Reduce the risk of hearing loss from noisy activities.



SAFETY GLASSES/GOGGLES

Prevent eye injuries from sparks, dust and chemicals.



COVERALLS

Provide full-body protection from dirt. dust and heat.
