## > DEFINITION OF 'LINE OF FIRE'

'Line of Fire' refers to a situation where a person is in harm's way, either by being directly in the path of a moving object or hazard, or by being struck by released energy, resulting in serious injury or death.

## MAJOR CATEGORIES OF 'LINE OF FIRE' HAZARDS

**Striking Hazard:** Being hit by falling objects or by moving vehicles.







**Crushing Hazard:** Body parts get caught in, on or between two objects.







**Stored Energy Hazard:** Unexpected released of hazardous stored energy.
